1. Introduction

This document provides information about changes made to the Emoveo application for version 2.8.1. It contains information that is not included in the manuals. It was written for:

- Emoveo administrators
- Emoveo technical support personnel

2. Installation Notes

Emoveo 2.6+ is required before you apply version 2.8.1

To upgrade:

- 1. Navigate to the Emoveo app base path using your console of choice.
- 2. Stop the Emoveo instance: env/bin/python stop.py
- 3. Backup the Emoveo app directory and database schema.
- 4. Install Python3.9.
- 5. Copy all files/folders (emoveo.zip) from the installation bundle into the app base path overwriting as needed.
- 6. Install cryptography module:

```
python3.9 -m pip install --user cryptography==2.9
```

7. Run configure script and enter database and application data:

```
python3.9 configure.py
```

8. Execute the following command:

```
python3.9 install.py --upgrade --pypi --python-bin python3.9
```

9. Copy license file from backup directory to fresh install. For example:

```
cp emoveo-old/license.py emoveo/
```

10. Once the upgrade is completed, start Emoveo:

```
env/bin/python start.py
```

3. Enhancements and Fixes

Emoveo version 2.8.1 includes the following changes.

Change	Details
Core / Foundation	 Support and certification of Oracle 19C. Internal Django version updated to version 2.2.20. Workflow step notifications can now be sent through SMTP. Application Code permission bugs fixed.
User Interface	 Package pages stay on scroll position after editing a line. Search filters are now retained in user cookie session. New tabbed UI for configuration screens. Cleaner inline forms on workflow configuration page. Redesigned package editor page: Lines detail table no longer in separate table and optimized for faster loading, maximum screen area utilization, and vertical scrolling. Separate footer area introduced with arrows for horizontal scrolling. Arrow keys can be used for navigation.
Administration	 Installation scripts are now Python version agnostic. Databases can now be imported and exported using JSON. Ability to add/remove users from a Security Group from the security group screen.
